****Ophthalmology Surgery Information**

Thank you for choosing Barnes-Jewish Hospital as your healthcare provider for your upcoming ophthalmology surgery. Our mission is to provide service and quality in a caring atmosphere. We designed this brochure as a useful tool in coordinating your care. We hope you will find the information given here helpful. If you have any questions, please call your physician.

****Arrival Time**

The date and time of your surgery are written on the following page of the brochure. An early arrival is necessary to allow adequate time for surgery preparation. Please bring this packet with you. Also, please bring your insurance cards and forms.

****Transportation**

Please make arrangements for a responsible adult to drive you home. For your safety and protection, you cannot drive yourself home and cannot be discharged without an adult escort. If transportation is not available, Barnes-Jewish Hospital can provide free van transportation for you within a 15-mile radius to and from your home on the day of your surgery. You may arrange for transportation by informing your physician. Transportation is not available for follow-up appointments or regular appointments with your doctor.

****Food and Drink Instructions**

For your safety - DO NOT EAT ANYTHING (INCLUDING GUM, MINTS, OR CANDY) NOR DRINK ANYTHING (INCLUDING WATER) AFTER MIDNIGHT THE NIGHT BEFORE SURGERY, UNLESS OTHERWISE DIRECTED! SEE MEDICINE SHEET.

****Medications**

You will be instructed about medications you will need to take the morning of your surgery. Please bring a list of all present medications with you on the day of pre-admission testing and on the day of surgery.

****Valuables**

Please leave money, jewelry, and valuables at home. Barnes-Jewish does not assume responsibility for valuables.

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****Personal**

Please do not wear make-up, facial foundation, body lotion, or clothing that must be pulled over your head. For your safety, you may be asked to remove contact lenses, eyeglasses, dentures, hearing aids and jewelry before surgery.

****Communication**

If you have difficulty understanding or speaking English, please bring an interpreter with you to the hospital.

****Waiting Area**

Please be aware that there is limited waiting room space. The person who accompanies you will be kept informed about your progress. Beepers are available if necessary.

****The Day of Surgery**

- Before surgery, you may be asked to remove contact lenses, eyeglasses, dentures, hearing aids and jewelry. Please bring containers, if available, for all removed items. You will be asked to change into a hospital gown, robe and slippers.
- After surgery, you will be discharged if a responsible driver is providing your transportation.

****Directions to the 4th Floor Surgery Center**

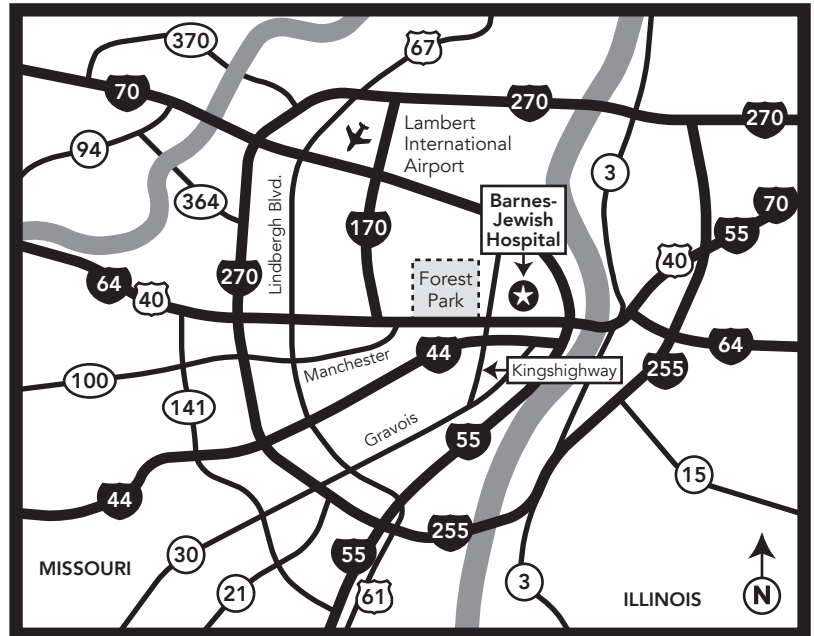
From Interstate 64/40, exit Kingshighway North, turn right on Parkview Place (East) to the garage straight ahead (across Euclid). Parking is available anywhere in the garage; there is a walkway on the 3rd Level. Walk over the bridge into the Center for Advanced Medicine (CAM). You will be on the 3rd Floor. Take the elevators on your right to the 4th Floor and follow the signs to the Surgery Center.

Barnes-Jewish Hospital/Center for Advanced Medicine (CAM) Area Road Map & Parking

Barnes-Jewish Hospital Complex is conveniently located in St. Louis, one block north of the I-64 (US 40) and Kingshighway Blvd. intersection. **The Center for Advanced Medicine (CAM)** is an additional two blocks north, between Parkview Place and Forest Park Avenue.

Parking: The North Garage located at Parkview Place and Euclid Avenue serves patients and visitors at the CAM facility. It is connected to the Third Floor of the Center for Advanced Medicine by a pedestrian bridge. Cost is \$1 per hour with a maximum daily rate of \$8. Relatives of patients may purchase discounted daily, weekly or monthly parking passes at reduced rate. For information, call **314-362-0732**.

Valet Parking: Valet parking is designed to accommodate patients who require easier accessibility due to health concerns and conditions. Valet parking at the Center for Advance Medicine is available Monday through Friday, 6 a.m. to 7 p.m. at the entrance of the Center for Advanced Medicine on Parkview Place. The cost for valet parking is \$2, plus hourly parking charges. The valet parking fee is waived for those displaying a handicapped license plate or mirror tag. OASIS and BJC Plus senior membership program participants receive a 50% discount on parking and valet services.



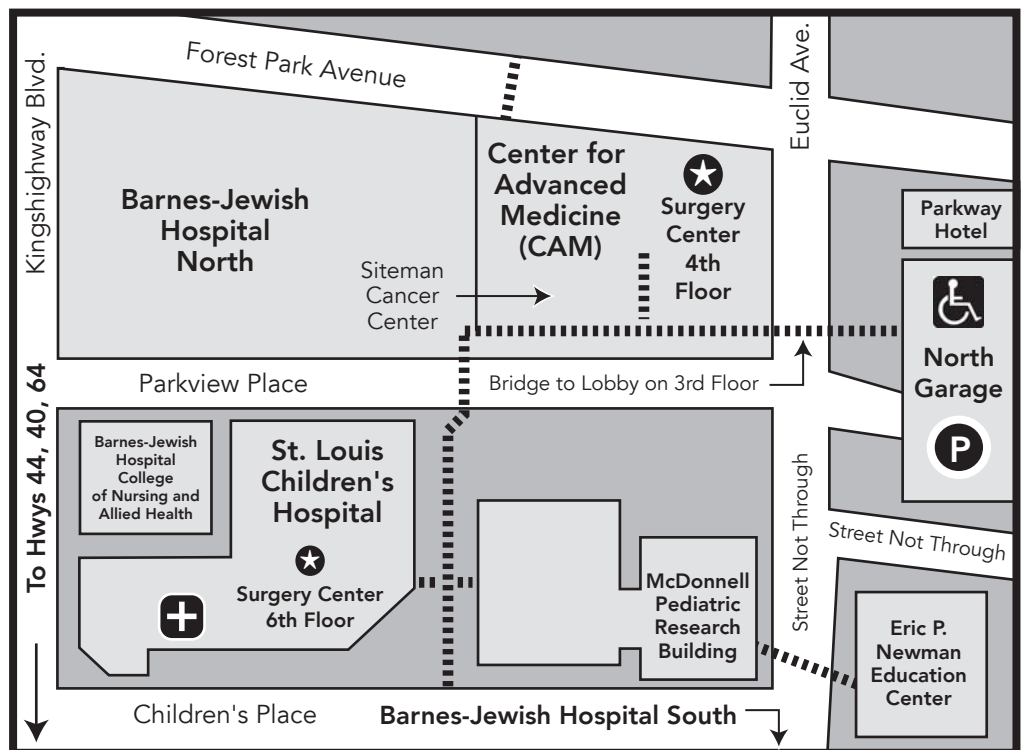
