



## What to Expect from Intravitreal Injections

- The day of the injection your eye may feel sandy or like something is in it. The eye may be sore or uncomfortable for 24 hours. Thereafter, if there is an increase in pain, please call your physician.
- Three days to a week you may see floating debris with that eye. This is normal and will start to settle in a few days.
- Occasionally, you may see a black circle or bubble that appears to be at the bottom of your vision. It may float or move as you move your head from side-to-side. This is normal and will disappear in a few days.
- You may be given a bottle of drops or a prescription for drops to be used as directed by your physician.
- Initially, you may experience your vision getting a little more blurred, but if there is a drastic change in vision such as, loss of ability to see light or a solid black shadow, please call your physician.
